MEMORANDUM

TO: All Cab Card Applicants

FROM: Monroe County Road Commission

SUBJECT: Application for Extended Transportation Permit (Cab Card)

The Monroe County Road Commission issues cab cards per power unit. A separate application is required for each power unit. The fee for each cab card is \$100.00 and shall be paid in advance with the application. In order for the applications to be processed without any delays, correct and complete information must be supplied on the application form. The cab card application form may be obtained on the Road Commission web site for your convenience (www.mcrc-mi.org).

In order to help preserve the roads under the Monroe County Road Commission jurisdiction, the Board of County Road Commissioners at a meeting March 10, 2007 supported and approved the reduction of maximum gross axle weights from 24,000 lbs. to 22,500 lbs. Please note cab cards are valid only on vehicles/equipment with loaded axle weights of less than 22,500 lbs. per axle, 14 feet high and 12 ½ feet wide. **Again, in accordance with Section 257.719a of the Michigan Vehicle Code, extended transportation permits for mobile/modular homes will be limited to 12 feet in width.** Maximum gross weight is still set at 148,000 lbs. Cab cards will be issued for the time period from April 1st of the current year to March 31st of the following year. **Please note that Cab Cards must abide by the Seasonal Weight Restrictions and all posted roads and posted bridges.**

All moves on Monroe County Road Commission roads in excess of the above conditions and restrictions shall require Single Move Permits. The single move permit application form may be obtained at the above-mentioned Road Commission web site. Please note, applications for such single move permits must be received by our office not less than two (2) working days before they are issued.

If a permit is granted, the applicant agrees to comply with all the special provisions listed on the permit card and all the rules and regulations listed.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Cab Cards are per power unit. The driver of the vehicle shall carry the original Cab Card Permit in the vehicle to which it applies and it shall be available for inspection by any police officer, Motor Carrier Officer or agent of the Monroe County Road Commission.
2. This permit is for the transportation of oversize, overweight loads not to exceed dimensions of 12 1/2' in width, 14' in height, 75' in length, or exceeding a gross weight of 148,000 lbs., nor may any axle weight exceed 22,500 lbs and 700 lbs. per inch of tire width except as otherwise stated on this permit. However, in accordance with Section 257.719a of the Michigan Vehicle Code, permits for mobile/modular homes will not be valid for dimensions exceeding 12 feet in width. All movements to be made on concrete based county roads (to the nearest intersection of the point of destination) before using other types of county roads. This Permit is VOID at any time road, weather or traffic conditions make travel unsafe.

EXTENDED TRANSPORTATION PERMIT ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

3. Permits are not valid for periods extending beyond the expiration date of vehicle registration. Permits will be issued only for vehicles owned by the applicant or operated under a bona fide lease or rental agreement.
4. Permits will not be issued for oversize or overweight vehicles or loads, which can be readily dismantled, reduced or otherwise, rearranged to come within the legal limits.
5. The permittee shall be responsible for damages to the highway, to persons and to property caused by or arising from operations covered by the permit issued. The permittee shall indemnify and save harmless the Monroe County Road Commission and/or its agents from any and all suits, claims, and damages of every kind arising out of, under, or by reason of this permit, or from operations covered by this permit.
6. Insurance coverage in the following minimum amounts shall be in force and effect for all vehicles operated under this permit of: \$2,000,000 Bodily Injury each person, \$2,000,000 each occurrence and \$1,000,000 Property Damage each per accident. Permits are not valid if insurance expires.
7. The movement of vehicle and load upon any highway shall be during daylight hours only. Permits are not valid on Saturdays after 12:00 Noon, on Sundays or during the period beginning at 12:00 Noon the day preceding and continuing until 12:00 Noon of the day following every legal holiday.
8. Permitted vehicles shall not unduly restrict other vehicles from their use of the highway and shall proceed in such a manner as to least impede the smooth flow of traffic. Vehicles and loads shall not be left on the highway day or night. No loading or unloading within the outer shoulder limits of any county road without special permission indicated on the permit.
9. Permits will in no way supersede posted axle or gross loading limits on any bridge structure.
10. Permit not valid on highways, which are posted for lighter than normal loadings and vehicle exceeds axle or gross loadings as posted, or when restricted loadings are in effect and roads posted. The applicant agrees to reimburse the Monroe County Road Commission for any damage resulting from the disregard of such postings on roads and bridges.
11. If this equipment is to be moved on any state highway, you must obtain permission from the state authorities having such jurisdiction.
12. Movement requires the display of clean, plain, red or orange flags of at least 18 inches square. One flag shall be displayed at each of the four corners of the vehicle or load, and if any portion of the load extends beyond the width at the corner flag, one additional flag shall be displayed at the widest point on each side of the vehicle or load. Flags should be securely fastened by at least one corner or securely mounted on a staff. When width exceeds 12 feet, an advance vehicle, displaying a flashing amber beacon and an "OVERSIZE LOAD" sign shall accompany the permit load.
13. PERMITS FOR OVERWEIGHT LOADS WILL NOT BE VALID DURING SEASONAL WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS. Permits shall be valid for oversize loads only when seasonal weight restrictions are met.

ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS SHALL IMMEDIATELY VOID THE CAB CARD AND SUBJECT THE APPLICANT TO APPROPRIATE LEGAL ACTION: (A) MISREPRESENTATION OF INFORMATION SET FORTH IN AN APPLICATION FOR PERMIT; (B) NONCOMPLIANCE WITH THE CONDITIONS, RESTRICTIONS, OR PROVISIONS ON WHICH A PERMIT IS ISSUED; (C) A CHANGE OR ERASURE ON CAB CARD.
