POLICY NO. 2012-31

**SPECIAL DESIGNATED, DESIGNATED AND
NORMAL LOADING ROADS**

I. SPECIAL DESIGNATED – ALL SEASON ROADS (as listed below).

These roads are in accordance with the provisions of Subsections 2 and 12 of Section 257.722 of the Michigan Vehicle Code. Seasonal load and speed limitations, "frost laws", do not apply. When Seasonal Load Limitations are in effect, no overload permits shall be issued and cab card permits are not valid.

1. Ann Arbor Road - Village of Dundee Limits north to Cone Road
2. Brown Street - Old US223 (Memorial Hwy.) west to a point of 150 feet (more or less) from the intersection of Railroad Road running north of Brown Street
3. Consear Road - from its intersection with the southbound exit ramp with US23 easterly along Consear Rd. approximately 1,250 feet and westerly along Consear Rd. approximately 325 feet
4. Crabb Road - US24 to Sterns Road
5. Day Road - Ann Arbor Road to Dundee-Azalia Road
6. Douglas Road - Michigan/Ohio border to 100' southerly of Sterns Road
7. Dunbar Road - US24 to LaPlaisance Road
8. Express Road - Bedford Industrial Park
9. Industrial Drive - Bedford Industrial Park
10. Lakeside Road - Minx Road to US24 (aka County Road 151)
11. LaPlaisance Road - Dunbar Road to I75
12. LaVoy Road - US24 to M125
13. Lewis Avenue - M50 to Westwood Street
14. Luna Pier Road - I75 west to M125
15. Nadeau Road - Southbound ConRail Railroad Track to Vivian Road
16. North Dixie Highway - I75 to Sandy Creek Road
17. North Dixie Highway - The north intersection of Swan Creek Road to US Turnpike
18. Reaume Road – 0.40 miles south of US Turnpike to US Turnpike
19. Samaria Road - Secor Road to Minx Road (aka County Road 151)
20. Secor Road - St. Anthony Road to Samaria Road (aka County Road 151)
21. Seventh Street - US24 west to a point approximately 1,250 feet
22. St. Anthony Road - US23 to Secor Road (aka County Road 151)
23. Sterns Road - Express Road to M125
24. Sulier Road - Bedford Industrial Park
25. Swan Creek Road - The north intersection of North Dixie Highway to I75
26. Schnipke Drive - Section Road to Sterns Road.
27. US Turnpike - North Dixie Highway to the Northerly County Line
28. Wolverine Drive - Nadeau Road to the southerly point approximately 3,700 feet

II. DESIGNATED - ALL SEASON ROADS (as listed below).

These roads are in accordance with the provisions of Subsection 2 of Section 257.722 of the Michigan Vehicle Code. Seasonal load and speed limitations, "frost laws", do not apply. When Seasonal Load Limitations are in effect, no overload permits shall be issued and cab card permits are not valid.

1. Benore Road - M125 to Michigan/Ohio State Line
2. Clark Road - Michigan/Ohio State Line to Yankee Road
3. Dunbar Road - beginning at centerline of LaPlaisance Road easterly 625 feet
4. Dundee Azalia Road - 333 feet north of centerline of Rogers Road north to Hatter Road
5. Erie Road - I75 to Consumers Power Company Driveway
6. Grafton Road – Matlin Road to Will Carleton Road
7. Head O Lake Road - Sterns Road to Old US223
8. Hurd Road - US24 westerly to the CSX Railroad Track
9. Ida West Road - US23 to City of Petersburg
10. Ida West Road - Lewis Avenue west approximately 1,100 feet
11. LaPlaisance Road - Jones Avenue to Dunbar Road
12. Lewis Avenue - Michigan/Ohio State Line north to Temperance Road
13. Lynch Road - Clark Road (south) to Clark Road (north)
14. Matlin Road – 0.15 miles West of Grafton Road to Grafton Road
15. Milan Oakville Road from Tuttle Hill Road to a point approximately 0.5 miles westerly of Wanty Road
16. Oakville Waltz Road - Exeter Road to Sumpter Road
17. Plank Road - Centerline of US23 southeast along Plank Road approximately 1,500 feet
18. Ready Road - beginning at the westerly edge of the I75 bridge deck, westerly along Ready Road to a point approximately 950 feet
19. Romine Road - Will Carleton Road South 0.60 miles
20. Section Road - Jeffs Roads west approximately 0.43 miles
21. Sterns Road - Lewis Avenue to Express Road
22. Sterns Road – Memorial Highway (aka Old US223) to Adler Road
23. Stewart Road - US24 to M125
24. Whiteford Road - beginning at centerline of Sterns Road north approximately 400 feet to StoneCo approach
25. Yankee Road - Clark Road to Memorial Highway (aka Old US223)

III. NORMAL LOADING ROADS

All other roads are normal loading roads and shall be in accordance with the provisions of Subsection 1 of Section 257.722 of the Michigan Vehicle Code. Seasonal load and speed limitations, "frost laws", are in effect in accordance with the provision of Subsection 8 of Section 257.722 and Subsection 6 of Section 257.627 of the Michigan Vehicle Code. During Seasonal Load Limitations, no overload permits shall be issued and cab card permits do not apply.

The Road Commission reserves the right to amend, alter or modify this policy at any time and in any manner without prior notice. This policy, signed and dated below supersedes any and all previously approved forms of this revised version of Policy #2012-31 (formerly policy # 94-3).


