US-23 CLOSURE BETWEEN M-50 AND PLANK ROAD

MONROE COUNTY, Michigan – The Monroe County Road Commission (MCRC) along with other various entities have determined a solution for local traffic in the rural areas of Milan Township, London Township, and Dundee Township. It is our current understanding that the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) has deployed a contractor to install detour signs starting today which will indicate the through traffic and commercial vehicle detour route.

Local vehicle traffic may use the following primary road system detour:

Northbound: Northbound Ann Arbor Road to westbound Cone Road to northbound Wabash Road to eastbound Main Street to US23

Southbound: Westbound Main Street to southbound Wabash Road to eastbound Cone Road to US23

Motorists are **NOT** permitted to block the entrance to the fire station located on Wabash Road in the City of Milan.

A three (3) ton emergency loading restriction is in effect on the signed detour route under MCRC jurisdiction effective immediately and until posted signs are removed.

All US-23 through traffic and commercial vehicles **MUST** follow the MDOT detour as indicated below:

Detour for Northbound US-23: Eastbound I-475 in Toledo, Ohio to northbound I-75 to northbound I-275 to westbound I-94 to US-23

Detour for Southbound US-23: Eastbound I-94 in Ann Arbor, Michigan to southbound I-275 to southbound I-75 to westbound I-475 in Toledo, Ohio to US-23
