RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Insurance coverage required in the laws of this State shall be in effect for moves operating with an overweight or oversize permit.
2. Applicant to hold the Monroe County Road Commission harmless from all suits, claims, damages or proceedings of every kind arising out of the presence of the permit vehicle on the public highway.
3. Applicant to be responsible for any damages caused to the highway, its structures and/or appurtenances arising out of the permit move.
4. THIS IS NOT A PERMIT. THE PERMIT TO BE ISSUED IS NOT VALID FOR:
 - a) Movement made on Saturday after 12:00 Noon, Sunday, holiday or between Sunset and Sunrise.
 - b) Movement on State Highways.
 - c) Movement of vehicles equipped with hard rubber or steel tires.
 - d) Movement on County Roads which are posted for lighter than normal loadings and vehicle exceeds axle loadings as posted.
 - e) Movement composed of units or assemblies which can be dismantled, reduced or otherwise rearranged to come within the legal limits.
 - f) Vehicle speed in excess of listed speed.
 - g) Movement over posted bridges if vehicle exceeds in any way postings on bridges.
 - h) Use if operator of vehicle does not have permit in his possession at the time of moving.
 - i) Misrepresentation of facts and information on application.
 - j) Movement not made on the date specified on the permit.
 - k) Vehicles to be loaded or unloaded within the outer shoulder limits of the highway.
 - l) Loads exceeding 700 lbs. per inch of tire width on any wheel.
5. On an oversize permit application, it is the applicant's responsibility to notify all overhead utility companies. Evidence of utility approval is required by the Road Commission prior to issuing the permit.

NOTE: The least width or length dimension becomes the width of the load. SHOVELS, CRANES, BACK HOES, etc., to be loaded lengthwise of the vehicle they are transported by.
