

MONROE COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Road Commission intends to protect, maintain and improve roads in the County of Monroe, Michigan, and

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Road Commission recognizes the importance of having a network of roads available for truck traffic, and

WHEREAS, the National Truck Network includes US-23, US-24 and M-50, and

WHEREAS I-75, I-275 and US-223 are Special Designated Highways, and

WHEREAS the Federal Highway Administration, U.S. Department of Transportation, issued regulation 23 CFR 658.19 requiring states to allow reasonable truck access within one mile of the National Truck Network, hereafter referred to as "NTN", and

WHEREAS the Michigan Department of Transportation expands access to allow travel of five miles on state highways only, from designated NTN highways, for access to or from points of origin or destination and facilities for food, fuel, repairs, and rest, and

WHEREAS, the County Highway Engineer is developing a truck route map accommodating commercial traffic along County roads, to be enforced by township truck route ordinances,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Monroe County Road Commission hereby provides reasonable access for trucks using County roads as follows:

1. Trucks may travel up to one mile on roads under the jurisdiction of the Monroe County Road Commission in order to travel to or from a NTN designated highway to or from its point of loading or unloading, or a facility its operator uses for food, fuel, repairs or rest.
2. All trucks with a height or length exceeding the standard limits specified in Public Act 300 of 1949, as amended, Michigan Compiled Laws Section 257.719 of the Michigan Vehicle Code, or with loading violating MCL 257.722, shall not use County Roads without prior approval and a permit from MCRC.
3. All trucks must comply with all posted weight limits on bridges, culverts and roads.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Monroe County Road Commission hereby revokes the Resolution dated August 1, 1996 and any Resolution inconsistent with the terms of this Resolution.
