CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS **Week of April 15, 2019**

LaSalle Township

North Otter Creek – M-125 to Telegraph

Gerken Paving is scheduled to begin paving N. Otter Creek between M-125 and Telegraph Road during the week of April 15th. The road will be closed to through traffic while construction is taking place.

Bedford Township

Summerfield Road between Douglas Road and Sterns Road

The contractor will be performing upgrades to the guardrail endings on Summerfield Road between Douglas Road and Sterns Road during the first part of the week of April 15th. During the work, two-way traffic will be maintained on Summerfield Road with single lane closures and traffic regulator control. Short-term delays should be expected when traveling through the work zone during working hours.

Berlin Township

Dauncy – Armstrong to Township Line

Brandon – Sigler to Village Limits

Haggerman – Labo to Sigler

Newport – N. Dixie Hwy to Armstrong

The above mentioned roads will receive a 2" aggregate stone lift during the week of April 13th. The roads will be closed to through traffic while construction takes place.

Exeter Township

South Stony Creek Road between Palmer Road and Timbers Road, at Herkimer Drain.

South Stony Creek Road between Palmer Road and Timbers Road will be closed to all traffic due to a culvert failure at the Herkimer Drain. The closure is approximately 1 mile east of Palmer Road and 1/2 mile west of Timbers Road.

The signed detour for this closure will be via Oakville Waltz Road and Sumpter Road.

This closure will remain in effect until the culvert can be replaced. The Road Commission and Drain Commission are currently working on the process of ordering the materials and preparing a bid for the culvert replacement.

Ida Township

Lewis Avenue from Rauch Road to Lulu Road

The contractor will be replacing the culvert wing walls at the county drain crossings on Lewis Avenue between Rauch Road and Lulu Road during the week of April 15th. During the work, two-way traffic will be maintained on Lewis Avenue with single lane closures and traffic regulator control. Short-term delays should be expected when traveling through the work zone during working hours.
