



MONROE COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION

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CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS Week of August 5, 2019

Ash Township

Sweitzer – Sigler to Ready

The Monroe County Drain Commission will be closing Sweitzer Road at the Little Swan Creek Drain for replacement of the culvert under the road. The closure is located between Sigler Road and Ready Road. The closure is expected to begin Monday, August 5, 2019 and should take 4 weeks to complete, weather permitting. This will be a total road closure at the culvert. Local residents, south of the culvert will be able to access their homes from the Indian Trail Road intersection and those north of the culvert will have to come and go from the Ready Road intersection. Due to the short duration of the closure and local nature of the traffic a detour will not be signed.

Ash / Exeter Townships

Exeter Road – Sigler to Carleton West

Exeter Road between Nolan Road and Scofield Carleton Road Culvert Replacement: Exeter Road at Little Swan Creek is completely closed to all traffic at the culvert. Those living north of the bridge will have to access their homes from Scofield-Carleton Road and those south of the bridge from Nolan Road. The signed detour route around the project is via Sigler Road, Maxwell Road and Carleton West Road. Exeter Road is expected to be opened back up to traffic in Mid-September.

Bedford Township

Crabb Road – Erie to Rauch

Gerken Paving is tentatively scheduled to begin paving Crabb Road between Erie and Rauch the week of August 5th. Shoulder work will follow paving. The road will be closed to through traffic until paving is completed.

Douglas Road – Samaria to Rauch

Tenmile Creek is tentatively scheduled for base stabilization on Douglas Road from Samaria to Rauch the week of August 5th in preparation of HMA overlay surface. The paving should take place 1-2 weeks after the base stabilization is completed. Shoulder work will follow paving. The road will be closed to through traffic until paving is completed.

Lewiston Estates Subdivision off Lewis Avenue

Work scheduled for the upcoming week on the Lewiston Estates Special Assessment District project includes driveway removals, ditch cleanout and installation of driveway culverts and storm sewers. Access to residences within the subdivision will be maintained during construction; however, motorists are

encouraged to use caution when traveling through the work zone. Work in the Lewiston Estates Subdivision is expected to last through late-September.

Sterns Road from Jackman Road to US-24 (Telegraph Road)

Gerken Paving is scheduled to perform cold milling on Sterns Road between Jackman Road and US-24 (Telegraph Road) during the latter part of the week of August 5th. The cold milling is being done in preparation for a hot mix asphalt overlay on Sterns Road which is tentatively scheduled for the week of August 12th. During the cold milling operation, two-way traffic will be maintained on Sterns Road with single lane closures and traffic regulators. Short-term delays should be expected when traveling through the work zone during working hours.

Whiteford Center Road from the Ohio state line to Section Road

Whiteford Center Road will remain closed to through traffic between the Ohio state line and Sterns Road during work on a road rehabilitation project. Work scheduled for the upcoming week includes mailbox relocations, slope restoration and pavement markings. Whiteford Center Road is expected to remain closed to through traffic until mid-August.

Exeter Township

Colf – Between Martinsville and Carleton West

The Monroe County Drain Commission will be closing Colf Road at the Davis Drain for replacement of the culvert under the road. The closure is located between Martinsville Road and Carleton West Road. The closure is expected to begin Wednesday, August 6, 2019 and should take one week to complete, weather permitting. This will be a total road closure at the culvert. Local residents west of the culvert will be able to access their homes from the Martinsville Road intersection and those east of the culvert will have to come and go from the Carleton West Road intersection. Due to the short duration of the closure and local nature of the traffic a detour will not be signed.

S.Stony Creek – Sumpter to Palmer

August 8th, Tenmile Creek is tentatively scheduled to begin trenching and pre-pulverization on S. Stony Creek Road between Sumpter and Palmer. Base stabilization will follow this process and paving should take place 1-2 weeks after the base stabilization is completed. Shoulder work will follow paving. The road will be closed to through traffic until paving is completed.

LaSalle / Monroe Township

LaPlaisance – Knab and Monroe Township Line

LaPlaisance Road between Knab and Monroe Township Line is tentatively scheduled for a single chip seal during the week of August 5th. The road is scheduled to be swept the following day. The road will be closed to through traffic during construction. All work is weather permitting.

London Township

Palmer Road – Darling and Grames

Monroe County Road Commission's tile crew is tentatively scheduled to begin removing and replacing a cross tile on Palmer Road, south of Darling the week of August 5th. The road will be closed to through traffic and remained closed through August 15th. The detour route while the cross tile is being replaced will be Oakville Waltz to Sumpter, then to S. Stony Creek. All work, weather permitting should be completed by Thursday afternoon, August 15th.

Monroe Township

**Evergreen Acres – US 24 to Dunbar
N. Monroe Miscellaneous Plats – Union
7th Street – Herr to US 24**

The above listed roads are tentatively scheduled for a single chip seal during the week of August 5th. The roads are scheduled to be swept the following day. The roads will be closed to through traffic during construction. All work is weather permitting.

Raisinville Township

North Custer Road from Ida Maybee Road to Doty Road

Lois Kay Contracting is tentatively scheduled to begin the asphalt joint repairs on North Custer Road between Ida Maybee Road and Doty Road during of the latter part of the week of August 5th. This work is being done in preparation for a hot mix asphalt overlay on North Custer Road which is scheduled for later this year. During the joint repair operation, two-way traffic will be maintained on North Custer Road with single lane closures and traffic regulators. Short-term delays should be expected when traveling through the work zone during working hours.
