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CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS Week of September 2, 2019

Ash / Exeter Townships

Exeter Road – Sigler to Carleton West

Exeter Road between Nolan Road and Scofield Carleton Road Culvert Replacement: Exeter Road at Little Swan Creek is completely closed to all traffic at the culvert. Those living north of the bridge will have to access their homes from Scofield-Carleton Road and those south of the bridge from Nolan Road. The signed detour route around the project is via Sigler Road, Maxwell Road and Carleton West Road. Exeter Road is expected to be opened back up to traffic in Mid-September.

Exeter Road – Nolan to CN Railroad

Ten Mile Creek is tentatively scheduled to pulverize the existing hot mix asphalt surface. Paving will follow in approximately 1-2 weeks. The road is currently closed for the Little Swan Creek culvert replacement.

Bedford Township

Lewiston Estates Subdivision off Lewis Avenue

Work scheduled for the upcoming week on the Lewiston Estates Special Assessment District project includes the installation of the hot mix asphalt base course on all roads within the subdivision. During the paving operation, access to residences within the work zone will be maintained with traffic regulators; however, delays should be expected during working hours. Work in the Lewiston Estates Subdivision is expected to last through late-September.

Exeter Township

S.Stony Creek – Sumpter to Palmer

S. Stony Creek Road between Sumpter and Palmer is tentatively scheduled for paving in approximately one week. Shoulder work will follow paving. The road will be closed to through traffic until paving is completed. All work is weather permitting.

London Township

Palmer Road – Oakville Waltz to S. Stony Creek

Palmer Road is tentatively scheduled to be paved the week of September 2, 2019. This is the base course and will be followed by a leveling course soon after. Shoulders will follow paving. The road will be closed to through traffic until paving is completed. All work is weather permitting.
