CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS Week of September 4, 2017

Ash/Exeter Township

Exeter Road – O’Hara to Nolan

A second lift of asphalt is scheduled for the week of August 28th. The road is closed to thru traffic and will be re-opened when work is complete. Expect delays.

Bedford Township

Crabb Road from US-24 (Telegraph Road) to Sterns Road

The contractor is tentatively scheduled to perform the pulverization and base stabilization of Crabb Road beginning on either Wednesday, September 6th or Thursday, September 7th. The base stabilization work will take approximately two days to complete, and the stabilized base will need to cure for approximately one week before the hot mix asphalt resurfacing portion of the project can begin. Crabb Road is expected to be closed to through traffic for approximately three weeks for the base stabilization and hot mix asphalt resurfacing of the road. Access to local residences and businesses within the work zone will be maintained during construction; however, motorists should use caution when traveling through the work zone.

Lewis Avenue from the Michigan state line to Pickard Road

The microsurfacing work on Lewis Avenue between the Michigan state line and Pickard Road is currently expected to begin during the week of September 18th. All of the resurfacing work on Lewis Avenue will be performed during nighttime hours to minimize disruptions to traffic. Once the resurfacing operation begins, the contractor expects to complete the work in approximately one week.

Shelton Ave. between Summerfield Road and McLain Ave McLain Ave. between Shelton Ave and Linden Ave

The Gradall crew is scheduled to start work again on September 5th on Shelton Avenue and McLain Avenue. Scope of work will be to install 1 cross tile, 8 drive tiles and removal of 1 catch basin, and 8 existing drive tiles and ditching. Traffic may not be allowed through during cross tile installation and removals. There should be no overnight closures. Due to the low traffic volume, there will be no detour. Weather permitting the work should be completed by September 15th.

Berlin Township

Lillian between North Dixie Highway and Leann

The tile crew is scheduled to start work again on September 5th on Lillian Avenue. Scope of work will be to continue removing pavement expansion heaves. Traffic may not be allowed through removals. There should be no overnight closures. Due to the low traffic volume, there will be no detour. Weather permitting the work should be completed by September 15th.

Dundee Township

Dennison Road – Kent Rd to Collins Rd

Dennison Road between Kent Road and Collins Road is closed to all traffic for replacement of the bridge at Middle Branch Macon Drain, 1/4 mile north of M-50. This closure is expected to last through early October for the bridge.

replacement. The signed detour is via Milwaukee Rd., Ann Arbor Rd., and M-50. Please seek alternate routes for the duration of the project.

Ida and Raisinville Townships

Ida East Road and Geiger Road from Lewis Avenue to Dunbar Road

Ida East Road and Geiger Road will remain closed to through traffic from Lewis Avenue to Dunbar Road for the first part of the week of September 4th, but both roads are expected to be reopened by the end of the week. Work scheduled for the week of September 4th includes the installation of guardrail on Geiger Road at the Pitts Creek crossing and the installation of the permanent pavement markings. Access to local residences within the work zone will be maintained during construction; however, motorists should use caution when traveling through the work zone.

Monroe Township

Dunbar Road from US-24 (Telegraph Road) to M-125 (South Dixie Highway)

The contractor is tentatively scheduled to install the gravel shoulders on Dunbar Road between Telegraph Road and South Dixie Highway on either Tuesday, September 5th or Wednesday, September 6th. During the installation of the gravel shoulders, two-way traffic will be maintained with single lane closures and traffic regulators. Short-term delays should be expected when travelling through the work zone.

Eastwood Drive – Dunbar Rd to Plum Creek Drive

The Eastwood Drive between Dunbar Road and Plum Creek Drive is closed to all traffic for replacement of the bridge at Plum Creek. This closure is expected to last through early October for the bridge replacement. Please seek alternate routes for the duration of the project.
