CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS **Week of September 24, 2018**

Ash Township

Grafton Road and Labo Road Intersection

The overhead flashers at the intersection of Grafton and Labo Roads will be replaced Monday and Tuesday, weather permitting. Expect intermittent lane closures while crews replace the flashers and wiring.

Bedford Township

Douglas Road – Samaria to Erie

The contractor is scheduled to base stabilize Douglas Road between Samaria and Erie during the week of September 24th, weather permitting. The road will be paved approximately 7-10 days after base stabilization is completed. All work is dependent on contractor schedules and weather. The road will be closed until the paving work is completed.

Jackman Road – Samaria Road to Rauch Road

The contractor is scheduled to continue working on Jackman Road between Samaria and Rauch during the week of September 24th, weather permitting. The road is scheduled to be base stabilized and will be paved approximately 7-10 days after base stabilization is completed. All work is dependent on contractor schedules and weather. The road will continue to be closed until the paving work is completed.

Mohawk Trails Subdivision off Dean Road

Projected work in the Mohawk Trail Subdivision during the week of September 24th includes the paving of driveway approaches, installation of gravel shoulders and slope restoration. Work in the Mohawk Trails Subdivision is expected to last through late September or early-October.

Ida Township

Todd Road between Douglas Road and Jackman Road

Todd Road will remain closed to through traffic between Douglas Road and Jackman Road during the week of September 24th for road improvements at the Ann Arbor Railroad crossing. Todd Road is expected to re-opened to through traffic in late-September or early-October.

Frenchtown Township

S. Stony Creek from Telegraph to Sumpter

The contractor is scheduled to continue the pulverizing and base stabilize on S. Stony Creek from Sumpter to Telegraph during the week of September 24th, weather permitting. The paving will also begin this week. All work is dependent on contractor schedules and weather. The road will be closed to thru traffic from the time the base stabilization begins until the paving and shoulders are completed.

Vivian Road Bridge at Sandy Creek, between Cole Road and Hurd Road

Vivian Road is completely closed to all traffic at the bridge over Sandy Creek between Cole Road and Hurd Road for rehabilitation. The project has been delayed due to bridge beam fabrication delays, with a tentative open to traffic date of October 5th and project completion in mid-October 2018, weather permitting. The signed detour around the closed bridge is via Cole Road, North Monroe Street (M- 125) and Nadeau Road.

Milan Township

Dennison – Hickory to Cone

Gerken Paving is tentatively scheduled to pave the base coat on Dennison between Hickory and Cone during the week of September 24th, weather permitting. A second lift of asphalt will be placed on the road soon after. All work is dependent on contractor schedules and weather. The road will be closed to thru traffic from the time the paving begins until it is completed.
