US-23 CLOSURE BETWEEN M-50 AND PLANK ROAD

MONROE COUNTY, Michigan – The Monroe County Road Commission (MCRC) was notified by the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) that US-23 is now open between M-50 in Dundee and Plank Road in Milan, Michigan.

The MCRC will continue to send crews to evaluate current road conditions, assess damage, and make repairs to the primary and local road system which was impacted by the US-23 closure. The MCRC will be diligently pursuing reimbursement for all costs incurred as a result of this closure. The patience of our local residents is greatly appreciated as we move forward with our internal processes.

The MCRC would like to thank all organizations and individuals who have engaged in identifying options to maintain safety for the motoring public and minimize damage to our infrastructure during the time of the closure. A special thank you to all MCRC staff who, over the last two weeks, were organizing crews, coordinating across entities, and utilizing all resources available to respond to the communities impacted.
